## EU Import Duties and TRQs

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Import duties and Tariff Rate Quotas (TRQs) are mechanisms used by the European Union under the Common Agricultural Policy. A limited volume of grain (the TRQ) which is set annually can be imported into the EU subject to the EU import duties calculated below. Once the TRQ is reached, grains can still be imported into the EU but at a higher rate of import duty. The EU Import Duties are recalculated weekly using world standard prices or if prices move more than \$5/tonne.

- 2) The 2,378,388 tonne TRQ for Wheat (Others) is split into 4 tranches. The Commission retains the right to advance tranches depending on market conditions. Any wheat left over from the first tranche has to be rolled over into the second etc.
- 3) The TRQ for wheat from the US & Canada, and the TRQ for barley is an annual volume with no monthly limit. This is available as of January 1st.
- 4) Once the TRQ limit has been reached, wheat will be subject to a 95 euro per tonne tariff, and barley a 93 euro per tonne tariff.
- 5) If the US quota is unfulfilled, this allocation may be opened to other countries subject to approval by the US.
- 6) Maize imports under the TRQ are duty-free, while those outside the TRQ incur the variable calculated import duty.
- 7) Tariffs for low and medium quality wheat and barley under the TRQ are currently suspended until the 30th June 2013. Quota utilised after this date will be subject to Tariff of 12 Euro/Tonne for Wheat and 16 Euro/Tonne for Feed Barley
- 8) TRQ remaining in future quarters is set to 0 until we enter that quarter.

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## EU Import and Export Licences

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Licences are required to import or export cereals and cereal products above set quantities into or out of the EU. Licences are not required for intra EU trade. This means the licences applied for can give a useful indication of the volume of trade with non-EU countries. Please note import licences are generally valid for the remainder of the month when the application was made plus two further months; export licences the current months plus four further months.
