EU Import Duties and TRQs

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Import duties and Tariff Rate Quotas (TRQs) are mechanisms used by the European Union under the Common Agricultural Policy. A limited volume of grain (the TRQ) which is set annually can be imported into the EU subject to the EU import duties calculated below. Once the TRQ is reached, grains can still be imported into the EU but at a higher rate of import duty. The EU Import Duties are recalculated weekly using world standard prices or if prices move more than \$5/tonne.

- 1) Calculated by subtracting the representative world (cif EU) price from the import reference price (current month's intervention price raised 55 percent). Except medium and low quality wheat and barley which are subject to the TRQ system.
- 2) For merchandise arriving into the EU by the Atlantic Ocean or via the Suez Canal (Article 2 paragraph 4 of Regulation (CE) No 1249/96) the Importer can benefit from a reduction in import duty of: 3 euro per tonne if the port of unloading is within the Mediterranean or 2 euro per tonne if the port of unloading is in Ireland, UK, Denmark, Sweden, Finland, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania or on the Atlantic Coastline of the Iberian Peninsular.
- 3) Official Duties from the European Commission.
- 4) Converted using the official customs euro sterling rate given above.
- 5) With a view to calculating the component of the relevant fob quotation, the following premium applies:
a premium of EUR 14 per tonne for high quality common wheat is added when the conditions tabled in Article 4 paragraph 3 of Regulation (CE) No 1249/96 are fulfilled.
- 6) The importer can benefit from a fixed reduction of 24 euro per tonne for flint maize when the conditions tabled in Article 2 paragraph 5 of Regulation (CE) No 1249/96 are fulfilled.
- 7) With effect from 5 July 2011 the representative cif import prices for sorghum and rye are those calculated for maize.

EU Import and Export Licences

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Licences are required to import or export cereals and cereal products above set quantities into or out of the EU. Licences are not required for intra EU trade. This means the licences applied for can give a useful indication of the volume of trade with non-EU countries. Please note import licences are generally valid for the remainder of the month when the application was made plus two further months; export licences the current months plus four further months.
