Import duties and Tariff Rate Quotas (TRQs) are mechanisms used by the European Union under the Common Agricultural Policy. A limited volume of grain (the TRQ) which is set annually can be imported into the EU subject to the EU import duties calculated below. Once the TRQ is reached, grains can still be imported into the EU but at a higher rate of import duty. Variable EU Import Duties are updated by the EU Commission if the duty calculation moves more than €5/tonne or returns to zero.
