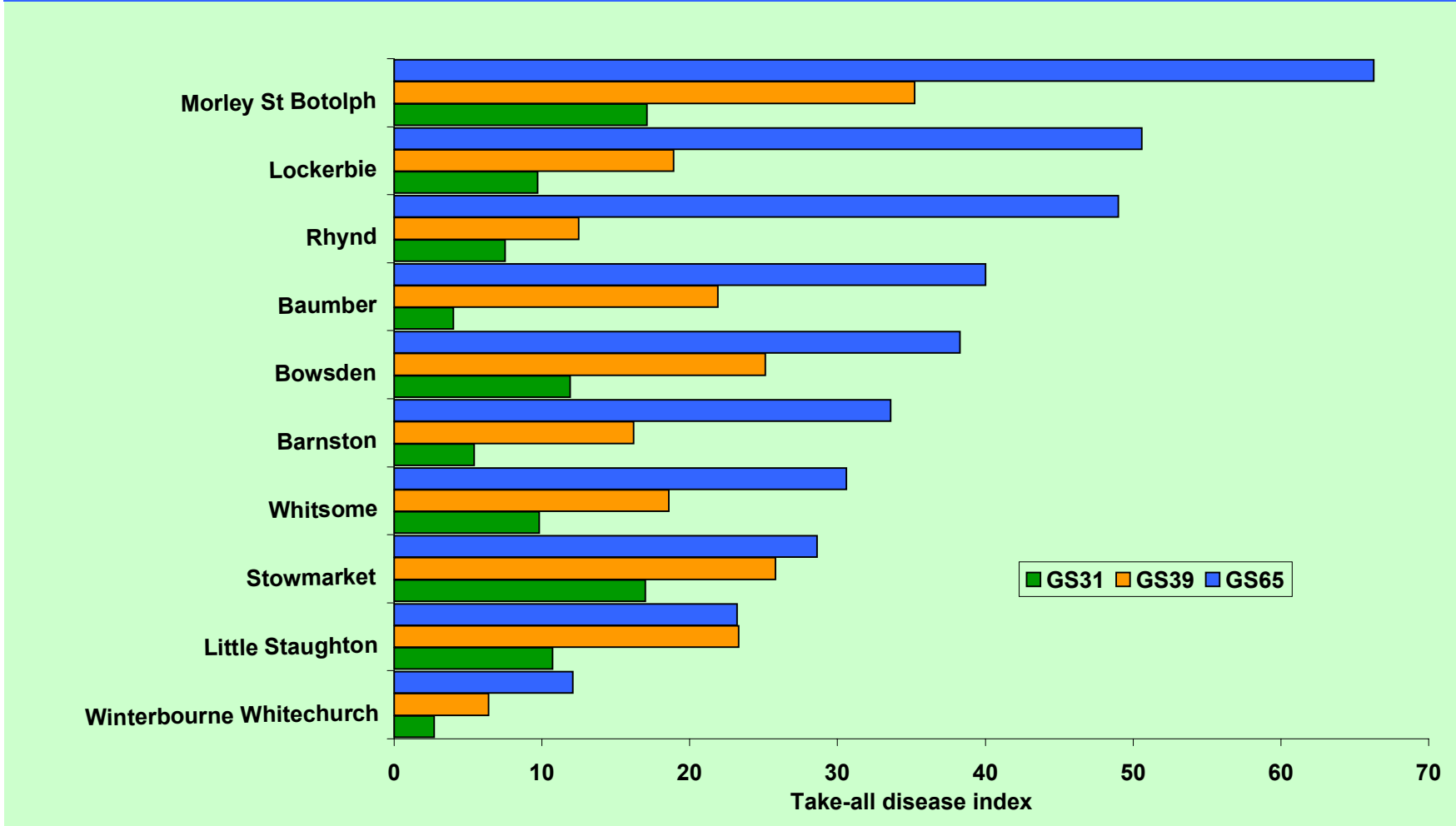

TAKE-ALL LEVELS IN SECOND WHEAT TRIALS



The graph below shows the average level of take-all recorded in HGCA Recommended List trials grown as second cereals in 2005. Plants from a single variety were collected from across each site and scored for take-all levels using a disease index running from 0 to 100 with 100 being the highest infection. The plant assessments were funded by Monsanto and carried out by NIAB. HGCA thanks them for this extra information.
